


HOME INSPECTIONS THAT LIVE UP

AN OUTSIDE PERSPECTIVE:



NAILING EVERY DETAIL: HOW STYLECRAFT THIRD-PARTY INSPECTIONS WORK

As a StyleCraft homebuyer, you don't have to do any work beyond reviewing your inspection reports and voicing any questions you may have to your Project Manager. We're here to coordinate everything.



THE VISIT:

Our inspectors will perform a thorough examination of the key areas of the house. We've highlighted each below, including just some of features, appliances, amenities, and more they'll be reviewing:



ROOFING:

The inspector will actually get on the roof to inspect the roof covering, gutters, skylights, chimneys and more to make sure everything is built to sustain the elements and always to code. If it's on your house, we're on top of it.



EXTERIOR:

Your home's exterior shouldn't just please the eye; it should be a highly reliable shield to keep everyone and everything inside safe, sound, and comfortable. We'll inspect the siding, flashing and trim, plus all exterior doors, decks, stoops, steps, stairs, porches, railings, rails, railways, and more. We'll also check the windows and double check that vegetation, surface draining and other factors aren't posing any threats to the structure.



FOUNDATION AND STRUCTURE:

The foundation lays the groundwork for your home to Live Up. We'll inspect this critical area, in addition to the basement, crawl space, and other areas — always keeping our eyes open for water penetration, cracking, and any other issues presenting potential structural and safety concerns today or tomorrow.



HEATING & COOLING:

StyleCraft goes well above and beyond the average homebuilder when it comes to optimizing homes' heating and cooling equipment from the get-go, doing so in a way that uniquely drives lifetime cost savings. Because of this, our inspections intensely vet the heating system and central cooling equipment, as well as visible distribution and venting methods, to make sure everything is dialed in to the right degree.



PLUMBING:

All homeowners know it's not bumps in the night that keep you up. It's the distant drip, drip, drip from a faucet... somewhere. Our inspectors will test all toilets, sinks, showers, etc. We'll also examine the interior water supply, as well as the drainage sump (if applicable). Finally, we'll review and accurately note the water supply, drain, waste, and main fuel shut-off valves, as well as the location of the water main and main fuel shut-off valves. And a whole lot more.



ELECTRICAL:

This is one of those critical inspection areas where the need for safety and efficiency converge. Our inspection includes the service line, the meter box, main disconnect, inspect panels, breakers and fuses, the service grounding and bonding, in addition to a representative sampling of switches, receptacles, light fixtures, and AFCI receptacles. We test and report on all GFCI receptacles and GFCI circuit breakers. Finally, our inspectors examine the service entrance conductors and smoke detectors, and report the presence of solid conductor aluminum branch circuit wiring.



INSULATION AND VENTILATION:

Our inspectors spend a lot of time in the areas you'll hardly ever visit. We inspect the insulation in unfinished spaces, the ventilation of attic spaces, mechanical ventilation systems, and report on the condition of insulation and ventilation in unfinished spaces.



INTERIOR:

It's easy to take for granted that all of a home's features well within your grasp are working just fine. But we won't let it happen. We inspect the walls, garages, ceilings, and floors, steps and stairways, balconies and railings, counters, and a representative number of installed cabinets, doors, and windows. Our also inspectors report on any signs of water penetration.

THE INITIAL REPORT:

Homebuyers receive the actual initial inspection report, a detailed and transparent deep dive into the all of the findings complete with photos.

THE WORK:

Any issues identified during the initial inspection will be resolved by the Project Manager. We're committed to delivering quality homes, so if we don't get it right the first time, we will invest our time and money to make it right for you.

THE FINAL REPORT:

That's right, we offer two distinct reports. After any needed work is completed, an inspector will return to ensure that any issues identified during the initial inspection have been reconciled and documented appropriately. (A copy of both reports is uploaded to CustomerLink, StyleCraft's online portal for all you need know about your home. This report may come in handy should homeowners choose to sell in the future.)
